Chairperson, Amy Hite, called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. with six (6) members present.

The first order of business was the approval of the Minutes from June 7, 2016. In this regard, LouAnn Colyer moved, seconded by Stacey Bacon, to approve the minutes. This motion passed unanimously.

It was announced there is a new bike pump station near the Neighborhood Walmart Market.

The first order of business was a discussion regarding safety concerns from the board members. It was reported the sidewalk on Centennial east of Knollview on the north side of Centennial has a large area that looks like has caved in. Troy Graham will look into this and see what can be done to repair this.

There was a concern about the Watco Trail at 4th and Walnut crosswalk needing to be repainted. Troy Graham will pass this to Joe.

It was also reported that at Homer and Ford on the sidewalk the concrete has sunk down significantly causing the water valve to become a safety hazard.

The second order of business was an update on the People for Bikes Grant. Kim Vogel indicated LiveWell is getting a pump station through their program. Several locations were discussed for a couple more. A work station was also discussed. Troy will be writing the grant proposal and send a draft to the group.

The third order of business was an update on the Sunflower Foundation Grant. Troy Graham indicated since the City didn't own the area going across the tracks the funding that was awarded \$9,000. The City needed \$26,000. After discussion with Lindsey the decision to hold the money for 6 months was made. Troy Graham will be reaching out to the railroad to see if they will be interested in assisting with getting the rest of the \$26,000.

The fourth order of business was an update on the County Wide Input Meeting for Trails meeting. Kim Vogel indicated the number in attendance was good. PedNet's website was pulled up for the group. The group reviewed the time line that was on the website. July 18th is the next County Wide ATAB. John Robb is on that board and will be assisting the group with getting organized. This meeting was an informational meeting.

In other business, LouAnn Colyer asked about the possibility of a crosswalk being installed between Lindburg and Golden Living to assist with pedestrian crossing. It was asked if a HAWK beacon would be able to placed near Tucker or Tucker Terrace. Troy Graham will put this on the agenda for the Traffic Advisory Board.

It was also announced that the plastic from the recent construction is still on the cross walk pads making the area of Centennial and Rouse very slippery when wet. Troy Graham will look into getting this removed.

There being no further business Amy Hite adjourned the meeting at 12:55 p.m. The next meeting will be held in the upstairs conference Room of City Hall on August 2, 2016 at 12:00 p.m.
