ORDINANCE NO. G-1215

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 42-35 of the Pittsburg City Code concerning the penalty due for delinquent payment of a business license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PITTSBURG, KANSAS:


Section 1. Section 42-35 of the Pittsburg City Code is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 42-35. When payable; penalty for delinquent payment.

All licenses shall be due and payable immediately upon the commencement of the occupation, business or profession for which the licenses are required. When any annual license shall expire, the license for the next year shall be due and payable on or before January 5 of the ensuing year. A ten percent penalty will be added to the license fees as set forth in Section 42-41 for any occupation, business or profession not renewing the license by February 1. An additional 20 percent penalty will then be added to the license fees for any occupation, business or profession not renewing the license by March 1. All occupation, business or profession failing to renew the license by May may be prosecuted under the provisions of Section 1-7 of this Code.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
