OLD BUSINESS

- Bird Control Downtown
 - o Potential Task-Force of a couple members to figure out the bird issue
 - Fields: Talked to Fish & Game. The starlings will be here year-round, they would rather come and make a 10-minute presentation about it to the Board. They don't like poisoning the birds because sometimes it harms other birds. He's willing to come to about any meeting to talk about it.
 - Fienen: Lets invite them to the next meeting. Also bring the PSU
 person as well so they can talk to each other and the board can listen
 to the conversation.
 - Brenner: Will coordinate these speakers for next month's meeting.
- Process for Event Funding
 - o Should only aid events rather than individual businesses.

- Potentially limit what funds can be used for. Contribute a maximum percentage of total costs. Require copy of SEP.
- Look over these sample applications for the next month or so, bring all suggestions and we'll make a final copy to be used.
