3. Discuss NE Quadrant Meeting - Lacy O'Malley, Ryan Williams

- Ryan gave a recap of the meeting, wants to have a NE specific open house
- Social Media groups could be implemented for each region / neighborhood
- Would like to get a cleanup effort started in the neighborhoods, maybe utilizing social media platforms to generate turnout
- Lacy suggested meeting in our quadrants within the NAC meeting time or outside the NAC time to get efforts started for each quadrant
- Sarah mentioned that the NE quadrant is the most densely populated & also sees the most codes issues
- Sarah talked about how the first bulky item pickup day was all 4 quadrants in one day & that it's okay to start small and learn from lessons as we expand.
- City Resources will always be available to the NAC & any efforts we coordinate
- Can we analyze data from codes infractions to find areas of improvement?
- Lacy pointed out that the goal is to unite communities we can't manage social media for all neighborhoods in Pittsburg, it would be up to each neighborhood to break off
- Not all citizens use Facebook or check emails or use technology important to remember

- Utilizing NextDoor or similar apps to increase our reach.

- Bob indicated that we should also probably get translations of the NAC letter
- Kristin will also see about translators for the event with Key Club
